#### **Board Records & Communication**

- Potter will monitor the email account for now.
- Steve Moese will provide Google Drive Training to the Board of Directors.

Isaac Stephani will have access and can answer emails from members that are about CBC games. No board issues should be brought to this email address. **Columbus NABC** – We need to drum up more excitement for the event. AJ and Bob are preparing presentations for NLMs. Potter is extracting the schedule for I/N players to share with his students. We need to elevate the awareness and enthusiasm among our members to attend and support this important event. Potter will create a web tool to capture member's preferences for volunteer work in

Columbus this March. Brenda Mehalko will share the link to the application so it can be posted to the NKy website. Brenda will promote volunteers from NKy. Pam and Brenda will work on sharing the volunteer list. Steve will create a version of the volunteer list for posting to the website so all can see what's filled and where the gaps are.

## How do we get people to use the Unit website more?

Mike Burns and Potter Orr will look into creating a "kiosk" in the CBC where i/N players can become familiar with the website. We all need to encourage all members to use their emails so they can receive our communications. 30% of our members do not provide us email addresses. Many do not visit the website. The Board will ask Isaac Stephani to coordinate an **AED training day** in May 2020 for interested members to train on this lifesaving device.

**Pianola** – Steve is working to get emails purchased for the Unit. The Board decided to stop funding Pianola for Clubs in Unit 124 because of rising costs and decreasing demand.
