
### Let's Talk Bridge

#### **Hand of the Week**

This week we look at a hand from Friday where not many reached game in the NLM section but many did in the open section:

## **Board 18 (Friday 1/9)**



NS 5♥; NS 4♦; NS 2N; NS 2♠; Par +650

Bidding – West with 14 HCP and 5 clubs opens the bidding 1♣ (12-21 HCP, 3+ clubs) North with 15 HCP and 6 hearts overcalls 1♥. East passes. South has 10 HCP and 3 hearts but with 4-3-3-3 distribution downgrading the hand to a simple raise of 2♥ is reasonable (6-9 HCP, 3+ hearts). West passes. North with a heart fit can now reassess their hand to at least 17 support points (15 HCP, one for singleton A, one for extra trump). With our points sitting behind the opener this hand will likely play closer to 18 support points. Either way, if partner has 8-9 points we want to be in game so we need to invite with a 3♥



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call. South with a clear maximum will go to game in 4♥.

Play of the Hand – On a ♣10 lead declarer (North) has 4 losers (1♠, 2♥, 1♦). Winning the ♣A and playing the ♥A and looking to finesse West for the ♥K actually drops the king immediately keeping our hearts losers to only one. You can develop your diamond suit to pitch your spade loser on the fourth diamond in dummy. This play loses only 1 heart and 1 diamond for 11 tricks and +650.

**Post Mortem** – When accessing your hand you can be more aggressive in hand evaluation when your HCP are well placed as North's hand is over West's on this deal. Always remember to add in support points once you have a trump fit.
