## Hand of the Week

This week features a Tuesday hand that requires you to change your expectations after partner shows extras in the bidding:

Bidding - North with 18 HCP and 5 hearts opens 1v (12-21 HCP, 5+ hearts). South has 13 HCP and heart support. To show this hand with only 3 card support South can bid 14 (6+ HCP, 4+ spades) and look to rebid $4 \checkmark$ later. Without 4 spades to support partner, North will rebid $3 *$ (18-21 HCP, at least 4 diamonds).

South with 14 support points for hearts ( 13 HCP plus 1 for the diamond doubleton) and knowing partner has a big hand should try for slam. If you play Blackwood or 1430 Roman Keycard Blackwood you will find partner with 3 aces and should bid on to $6 \vee$.

Play of the Hand - With a club lead declarer (North) has only 2 losers $(1 \downarrow, 1 \boldsymbol{*})$ but the diamond can go on the fifth spade in dummy for 12 tricks and +980 . If East open leads a spade instead, you can draw trump and run spades to pitch both your club and diamond loser for +1010.

Post Mortem - On this hand South expected only to get to game after partner opens, but needs to reevaluate the possibilities when North's rebid shows a big hand (18-21 HCP).
