This week features a Fri 10AM STAC hand where at first you are thinking game but later on you need to push to slam:

Bidding - North with 19 HCP balanced opens 1 (1221 HCP, 3+ diamonds) looking to rebid 2NT later if partner can respond. South has 12 HCP and 5 hearts. Immediately South should be thinking they need to get to at least game. Their first response is $1 \vee$ (4+ hearts, 6+ HCP). North with 4 hearts knows even if partner only has 6 support points they should be in game and should bid it directly at $4 \vee$ (19-21 HCP, 4 hearts). If you are South, do not immediately settle for game. Now that you have a trump fit your hand is worth at least 15 support points (12HCP, 2 for the singleton and 1 more for an extra trump). With 34-36 support points between the two hands you should be thinking of $6 \vee$ or $7 \boldsymbol{V}$. Bid $4 N T$ to ask for keycards. If you play 1430 Roman Key Card North will answer 5 (0 or 3 ). Given the auction it must be 3 so bid on to 6\%. If you play regular Blackwood you will find you are missing an ace and need to stop at $6 \vee$.

Play of the Hand - On any lead, declarer (South) has 12 tricks losing only the $₫ \mathrm{~A}$ for +980 .

Post Mortem - Make sure when partner shows lots of extras, like North did on this hand jumping to 4 4 on their rebid, that you consider your slam possibilities before passing. Sure at first you would have been happy in a heart game but when you have at least 34 support points you should almost always get to slam.
